GENERAL INFORMATION—This is an alphabetical list of service parts for Bodies, Shop Truck, ST-5 and ST-6. **WARNING:** Many of the parts listed herein are not stocked for issue. See ORD 8 of SNL G-227 for those parts stocked for issue. There is no ORD 7, SNL G-227, since an ORD 7 is published for each load that is mounted in a vehicle equipped with a Shop Truck Body, and a separate SNL No. is assigned to vehicles with different loads.

This list of all service parts is to be used for identification and storage purposes. Every individual part is not necessarily stored by itself; in fact many parts are stored as authorized assemblies. Such assemblies are indicated herein.

For full information relative to Standard Nomenclature Lists, the procedure followed and principles employed in the compilation, together with the purposes and uses thereof, see the Introduction to the Ordnance Catalog (ORD 1 IOC), the Ordnance Provision System Regulations (OPSR) and the Ordnance Publications for Supply Index (ORD 2 OPSI).

SPECIAL INFORMATION—This Standard Nomenclature List contains the parts of the ST-5 and ST-6 Shop Truck Bodies and the heater common to both.

Part A lists the parts for the ST-5 Shop Truck Body (non-collapsible type).

Part B lists the parts for the ST-6 Shop Truck Body (collapsible type).

Part C lists the parts for the Heater which is common to the vehicles with both the ST-5 and ST-6 Bodies.

ORD 9**SPECIAL INFORMATION (Cont'd)**

Each part and section thereof carries an explanation of that particular portion of the catalog, which covers the bodies as they are received by the Ordnance Department from the body Manufacturers, as well as the additional required alterations for each Maintenance load installed in the vehicle.

For data on the chassis built by General Motors (BMC) see SNL G-508; for data on the chassis built by the Studebaker Corporation see SNL G-630.

The vehicles equipped with the bodies reviewed herein are designated as Special Equipment, as defined in paragraph 3, AR 850-15, dated 28 August 1943.

The loads in these Shop Trucks (Ordnance Maintenance Trucks) vary with their functional purpose. Each load is reviewed in the ORD 7 portion of a separate G group SNL.

STOCK NUMBER

The Prefix and Number of the Stock Number (i.e. G138-XXXXXXX, G227-XXXXXXX) signifies that the particular part or component was originally coded under the major item designation for that SNL, and does NOT mean that the Part is used ONLY in that major item. All subsequent Lists for different vehicles will include the same Stock Number for this same part.

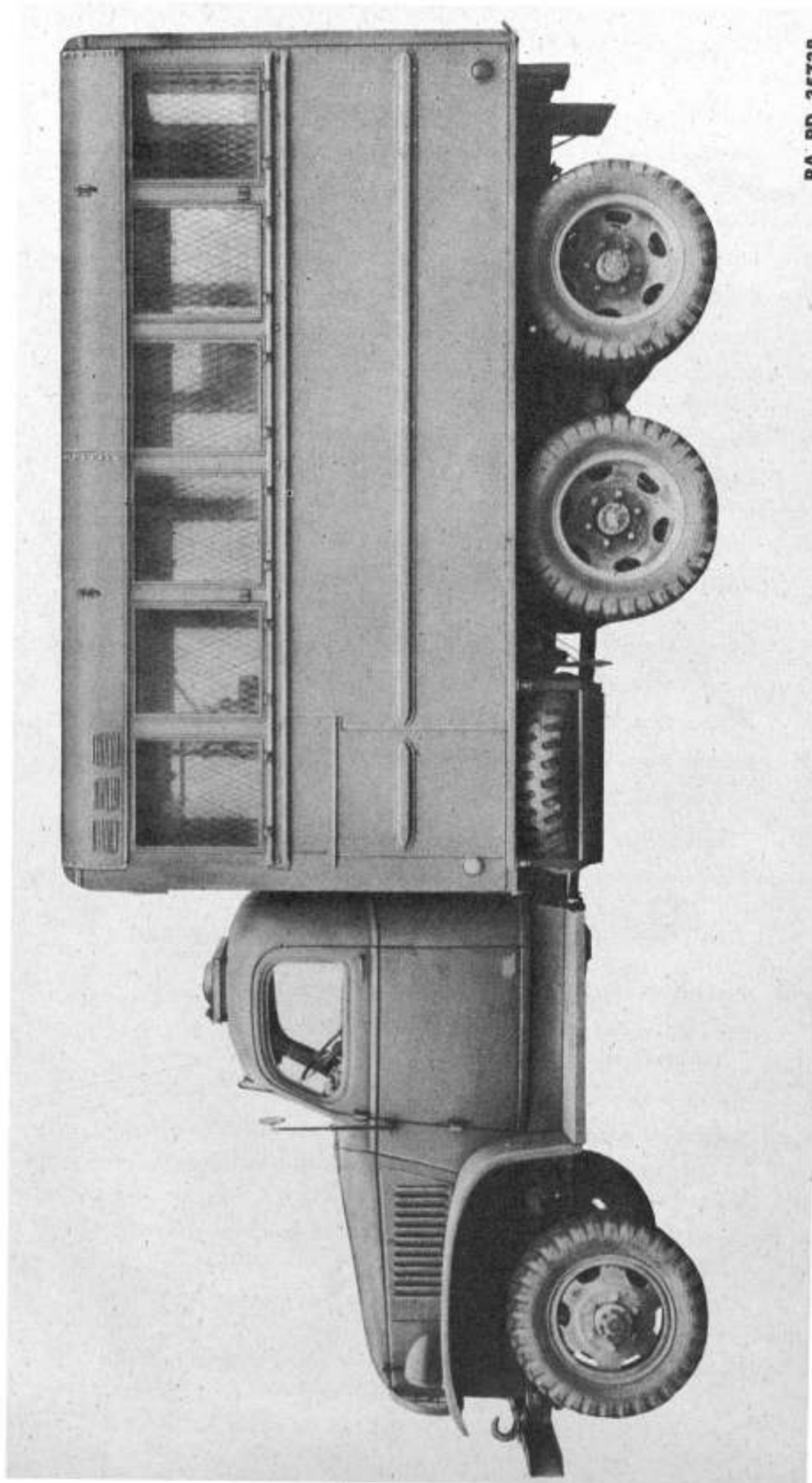

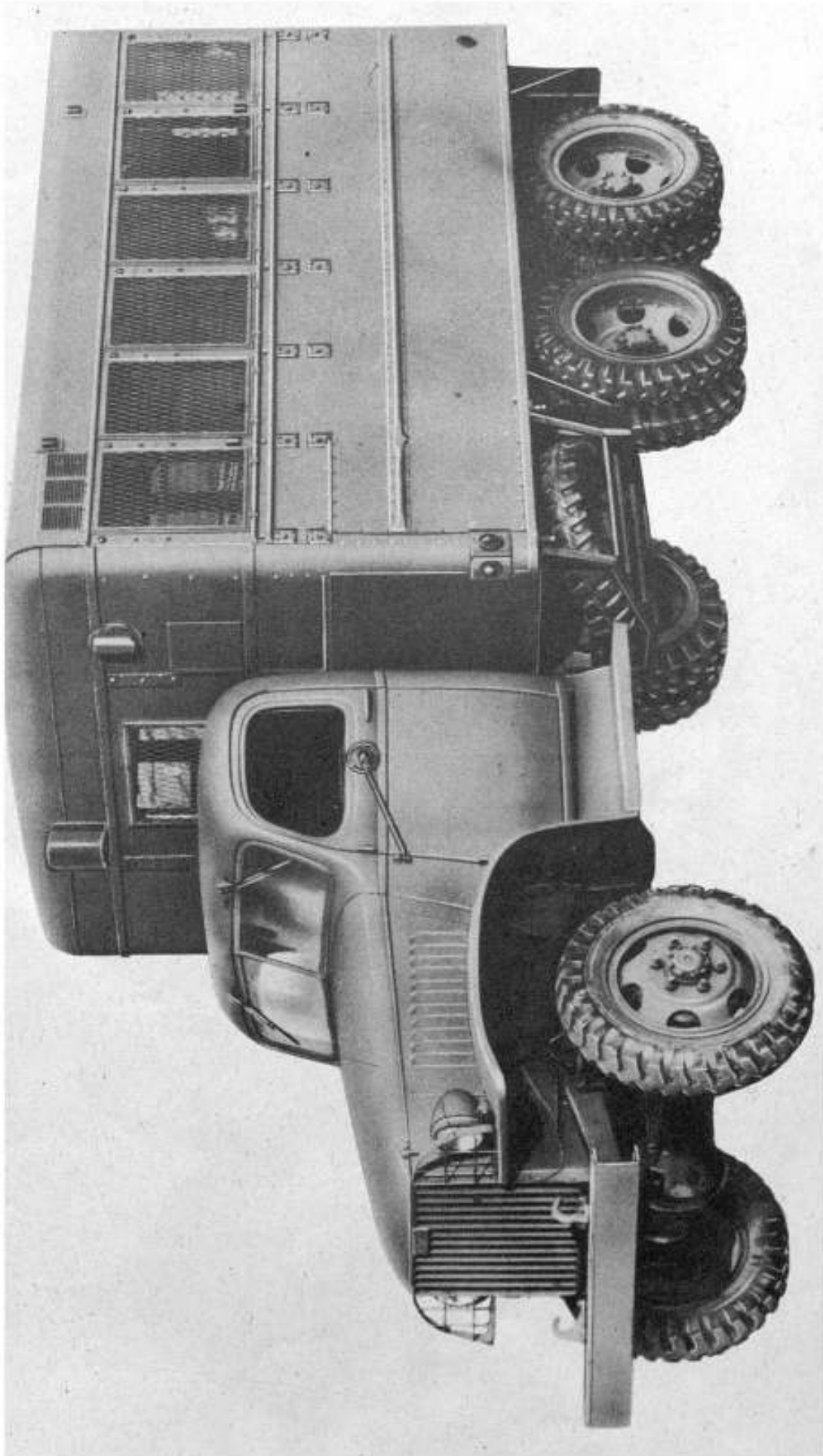


FIGURE B—ORDNANCE MAINTENANCE TRUCK WITH ST-6 BODY (COLLAPSIBLE)
