GENERAL INFORMATION—This is a list of all items of service for the Truck, 2½-ton, 6 x 6 (GMC Models CCKWX 353, CCKW 352, 353 and AFKWX 353); Truck 2½-ton, 6 x 4 (GMC Model CCW 353); Truck, Bomb Service, M27 arranged according to standardized government grouping. *WARNING: Many of the parts listed herein are not stocked for issue. See ORD 7 and 8 of the appropriate major combination SNL for those parts stocked for issue. In case parts not listed in ORD 8 are needed, separate requisitions for these parts should be forwarded through normal supply channels with justification therefor.*

This list of all parts is to be used for identification and storage purposes. Every individual part is not necessarily stored by itself; in fact, many parts are stored as authorized assemblies. Such assemblies that are items of service are indicated herein. The components, however, of such assemblies that are items of service are listed alphabetically within the appropriate groups with the number of each particular part required per unit assembly.

SPECIAL INFORMATION:

MAJOR ITEMS DESIGNATION: The major item covered by this catalog is designated as a general purpose vehicle, as defined in paragraph 3, AR 850-15, dated 28 August 1943.

COMPONENTS OF KITS, SETS AND ASSEMBLIES: Whenever any doubt might exist as to the components of an assembly, an explanatory statement or a complete listing of components is furnished. For all KITS and SETS a complete listing of components is given. Wherever separate items are shown which are also part of a KIT or SET that fact is stated.

ATTACHING PARTS: Attaching parts such as bolts, nuts, rivets, screws and washers are indented immediately under the part or assembly which they attach. Whenever two similar items, such as right and left cylinder heads, optional generators, two fuel tanks, superseding spring assemblies, etc., have the same attaching parts, these attaching parts are listed only after the last of the similar parts. The quantities shown for the attaching parts are for both right and left cylinder heads, or only one of the optional generators, etc.

ILLUSTRATIONS: This catalog contains various illustrations to aid the user in locating and identifying parts. These are so placed as to be convenient for reference in connection with the text. For each part identified on an illustration the noun, part number and group number of the item is given. An index of illustrations by number, title and page is included with other indexes at the back of the book.

INDEXES: Complete indexes, alphabetical and numerical, are furnished at the back of the book. These indexes and contents are explained in brief paragraphs at the beginning of each index.

STOCK NUMBERS: The prefix of the SNL type stock number (i.e. G067, G502, H001, etc.) signifies that the particular part or component was originally coded under the major item designation for that SNL and does NOT mean that the part is used only in that major item. All subsequent lists which include that same part will show the identical stock number.

DEFINITION OF LOCATIONAL TERMS: The words "left," "right," "front," and "rear," when used in this catalog, are as these directions would prevail from the driver's seat when facing forward.

IDENTIFICATION PLATES FOR VEHICLE AND PRINCIPAL COMPONENTS: Due to engineering changes made during production of a vehicle, it is necessary to determine the serial number of your vehicle to find out which replacement parts shown in the book apply to it.

The chassis serial number is shown on the plate located inside the cab on the cowl panel above the toe-board, and is also stamped on the R.H. frame side member above the front spring. The engine serial number is shown on the plate attached to the left side of engine crankcase and is stamped on the right side of the engine crankcase near the distributor.

Chassis serial numbers carry a suffix to designate the body type and certain other features which vary on the vehicles. Thus—A1 designates a vehicle with cargo body, without winch, and with split type axles. A complete list of symbols are given below, with their meaning:

INTERCHANGEABILITY OF COMPONENTS

Design Changes: If a part was shipped but was later superseded and the new and old parts are interchangeable, the old part is listed, with the note "Superseded by....." If the new and old parts are not interchangeable, the fact is indicated by the note "Used prior to serial number....."; after the old part, and after the new part, "Used on serial number..... and after."

Major Items: Some of the major units listed in this SNL G-508 (for truck, 2½-ton, model CCKW-353 with Banjo type axles) are interchangeable with those used on Truck, Amphibian, model DUKW-353. For instance, the Transfer Case Assemblies are identical; the Transmission Assemblies are the same with exception of the gear shift lever; the Axle Assemblies are the same with exception of the brakes and the drive pinion bearing oil seal retainer. The majority of the details of the major units are interchangeable and may be determined by referring to SNL G-501, in which the interchangeable parts are indicated by an asterisk (*) preceding the manufacturer's part number.

In addition to the above-mentioned units, the Engine Assemblies used on the model CCKW-352 or 353, may be interchanged with the model DUKW-353 Engine Assembly by removing and adding certain parts. These parts are indicated on the following chart.

This chart covers the various changes made in GMC type 270 engines to adapt them to different models and operating conditions. The engines used in CCW, CCKW, AFKWX and DUKW models are interchangeable by removing or adding certain parts. Parts required can be determined from the chart and lists that follow.
