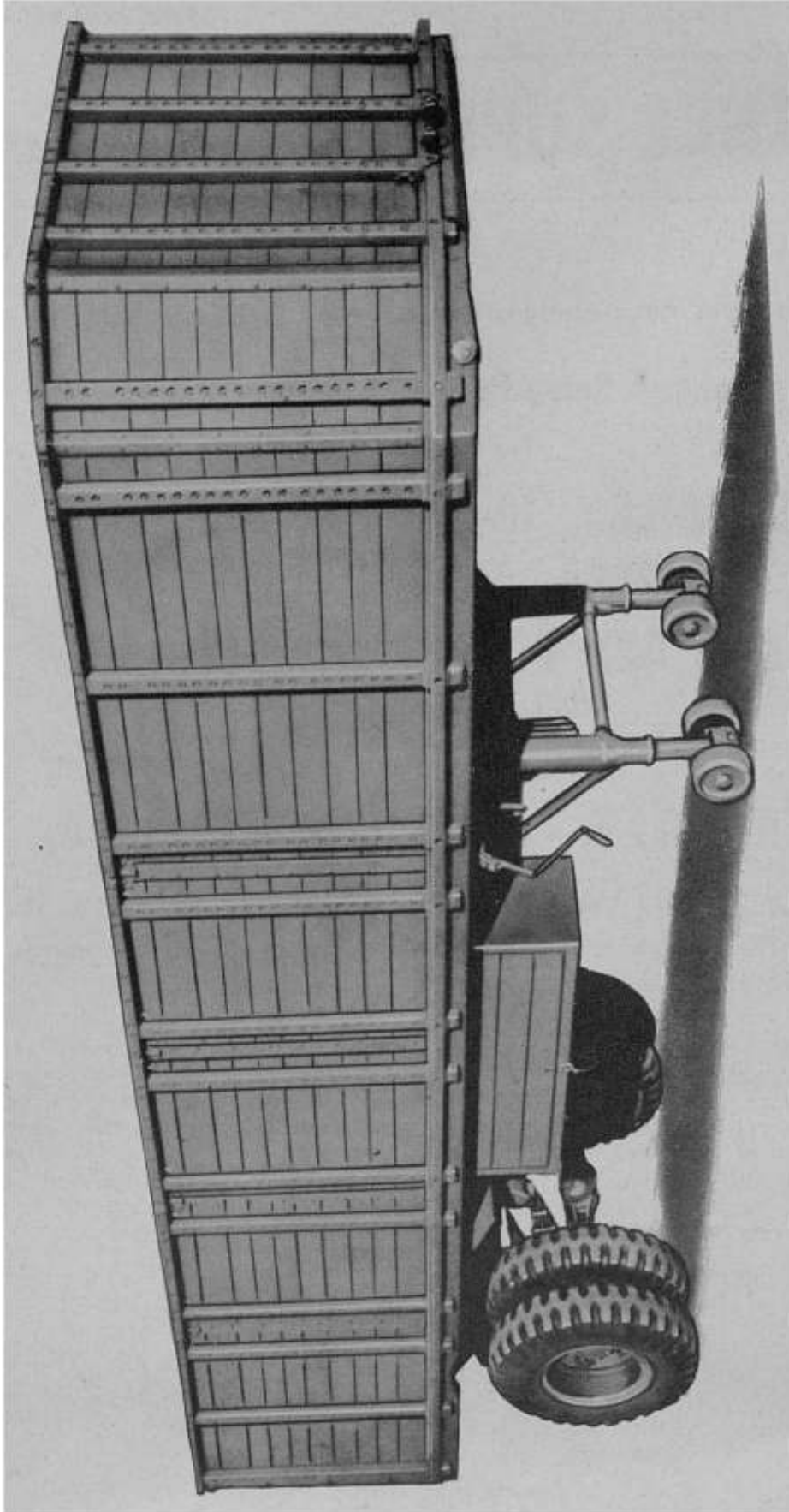

STAKE AND PLATFORM, 1944 (MODEL 1025)**

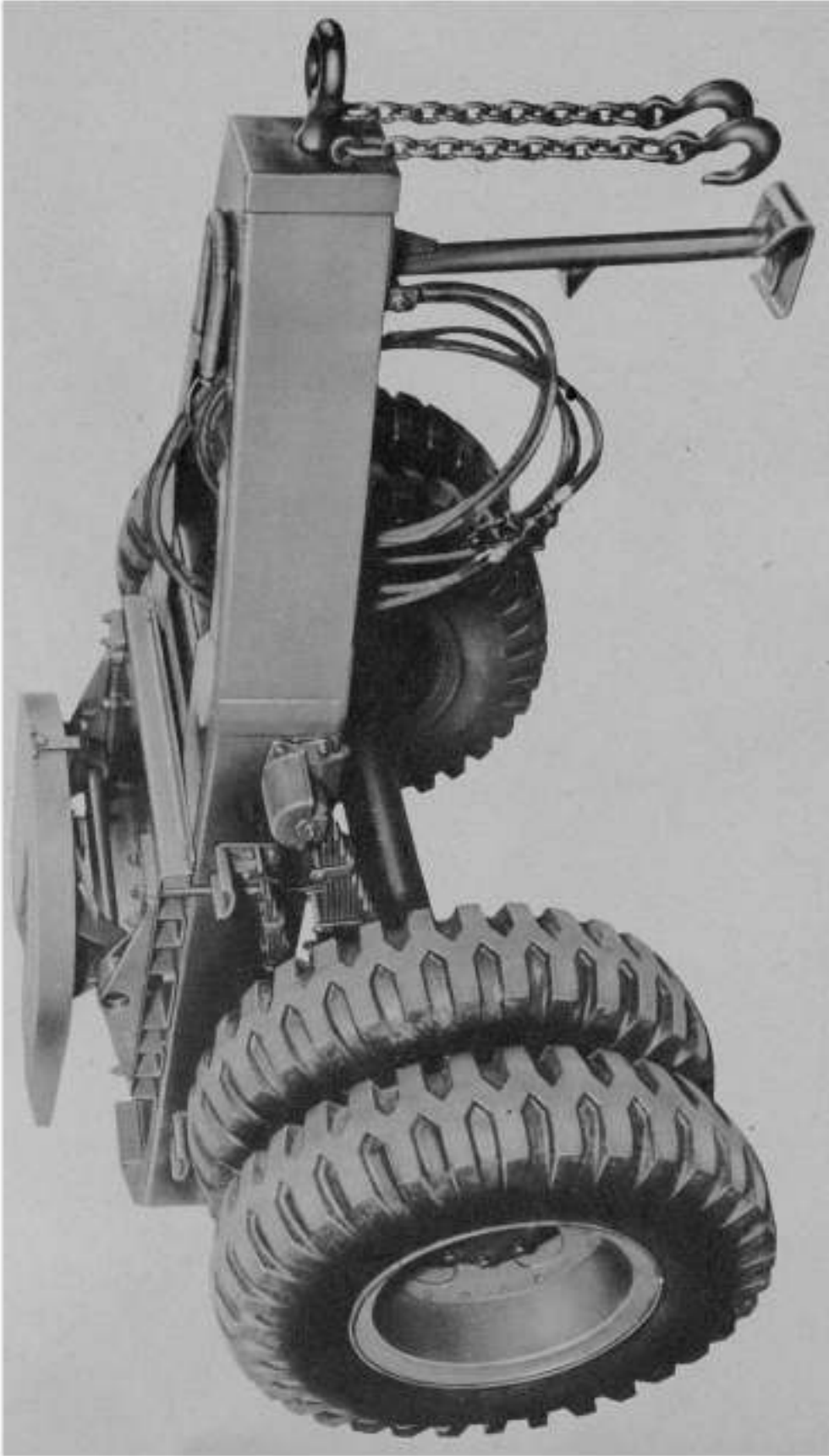


FIGURE 2—CONVERTER DOLLY, 10-TON, 2-WHEEL, 2-WHEEL (ZDT)
